AUTHORIZING ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID FOR PURCHASE OF FIRE RESCUE BOAT.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Fire District No. 1 in the Township of Hillsborough, County of Somerset have approved specifications for and have determined that they will advertise for sealed bids for the purchase of a fire rescue boat, hereafter referred to as "Station 38 fire rescue boat".

NOW, THEREFORE, be it RESOLVED by the Commissioners of Fire District No.1 in the Township of Hillsborough, County of Somerset as follows:

1. Specifications are hereby approved and incorporated herein by reference.
2. Bids to be submitted shall fully comply with the specifications.
3. The Commissioners shall advertise for the receipt of sealed bids for the above named purpose or project.
4. Each bid shall be submitted as a written proposal in the manner designated in the specifications and shall be signed by the bidder. The bid shall be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder on the outside, specifically denoting on said envelope the name of the job for which said bid is submitted and addressed to Christopher Weniger, Chief Bureau of Fire Safety, Commissioners of Fire District No, 1 in the Township of Hillsborough, County of Somerset.
5. The specifications, instructions to bidders and related documents may be obtained upon written or verbal request from the Hillsborough Bureau of Fire Safety 379 South Branch Road, Hillsborough NJ 08844, (908) 369-4313 during normal business hours.
6. Sealed bids shall be called for and shall be received, opened and read in public at the Hillsborough Bureau of Fire Safety, 379 South Branch Road, Hillsborough NJ 08844 at 4:00 PM prevailing time on October 3, 2018

7. Each sealed bid shall be hand delivered to, or mailed in time to be received by Christopher Weniger, Chief, or to such other designated representative of the Commissioners who will be present at the opening of said bids at the time and place stated for the receipt of sealed bids. **NO BID SHALL BE DELIVERED OR ACCEPTED AFTER THE DATE OR HOUR AS DESIGNATED IN THIS PUBLIC NOTICE.**

8. The bid quote shall be net to the Commissioners and shall be excluded from any state or federal taxes.

9. The contract will be awarded to the lowest, qualified, responsible bidder. The Commissioners also reserve the right to waive any insubstantial irregularities in any bid.

10. A non-collusion affidavit in the usual form will be supplied with the specifications. It shall be executed by the person or corporate officers submitting the bid. Said affidavit must be properly notarized. A non-collusion affidavit must accompany each bid. **THIS REQUIREMENT WILL NOT BE WAIVED.**

11. An owners list in accordance with P.L. 1977, c.33, approved March 8, 1977, will also be supplied with the specifications in the usual form. It shall be completed by the person or corporate officers submitting the bid. Said owners list must accompany each bid. **THIS REQUIREMENT WILL NOT BE WAIVED.**


12. Each bidder shall submit, in addition, a letter from a bonding company licensed to do business under the Laws of the State of New Jersey stating that the company will furnish a performance bond in the amount of 100% if its bid if said bidder is awarded a contract by the Commissioners. **THIS REQUIREMENT WILL NOT BE WAIVED.**

13. Bidders are required to comply with the applicable statutory requirements and regulations adopted pursuant thereto, including but not limited to P.L. 1975, Ch. 127; P.L. 1977, Ch. 33; P.L. 1963, Ch. 150; and P.L. 1933, Ch. 277, including all amendments thereto.

14. No bidder may withdraw his proposal for a period of 60 days after the opening of bids; all proposals being binding upon all bidders for said 60 day period.
